REGULATIONS

All school candidates must report to the venue in **proper school uniform** with their valid original school ID document, Valid Passport/CNIC/Smart Card and the **statement of entry**. Candidate without these documents will not be allowed to sit for the examination.

Disallowed items within the examinations hall (if found, will be confiscated and returned one week after the end of the May/June 2017 exam session)

Mobile phones, pagers, calculator cases/instruction leaflets, **bags**, books, pencil cases, personal stereos, computers of any kind, programmable watches, palm-top computers or any other kind of equipment are strictly prohibited inside the examination hall/room. Wallet(s) are strictly not allowed to be taken at the exams venue.

Security concerns and capacity constraints mean that we can no longer allow any school bags and electronic devices. We have an area reserved for open books only.

Allowed items within the examinations hall

Pens (blue or black ink only), pencils, erasers, slide rulers, mathematical instruments (only), non-graphical/non-programmable calculators (if required by the examinations) should be carried in **transparent cases only**. Please read carefully the instruction on the use of calculators and allowed books printed on a separate sheet.

INFORMATION

- Candidates entitled to Access Arrangements or candidates with Clash papers must carry a British Council letter confirming the arrangements.
- We strongly recommend that all candidates visit the venue ahead of the examination session in order to get familiarised with the location, traffic and parking facilities to avoid any inconvenience on the day of the exam.
- Parents, teachers and siblings are **NOT** allowed inside the examination venue.
- All valuables are the sole responsibility of the candidate. Candidates are advised not to bring any valuables with them to the examinations venue. The British Council will not be responsible for any loss of valuables or any other items at the examinations venue.
- Candidates are informed that the examinations supervisor may take immediate action against any individual, found to be disturbing the candidates inside or outside the examinations hall. Candidates found to be cheating, using any unfair means, or breaking the rules in any way may be disqualified from the whole examination session.
- It is **COMPULSORY** for all candidates to arrive at the examination venue **one hour** before the exam start time.
- Candidates are required to remain in the exam hall for the complete duration of their paper or candidates will be in the examination hall/room until the **KEY TIME finishes**.

- Parents are not allowed to stay at the examination venues including any assembly areas. Parents must follow a pick-up and drop-off policy since we do not have designated parking facilities. Motorists should simply follow the arrow signs for 'drop-off/pick-up'. **We will not provide any parking facilities to schools, candidates and parents at exams venues**

KEY TIME for Pakistan as communicated earlier is:

KEY TIME is the time stipulated on the final examination timetable at which you must be under full centre supervision.

Afternoon Session = 02.00 p.m. (Pakistan Standard Time)

PLEASE NOTE

If you have examinations which are clashing on the same time, day and centre number, and haven't received the information regarding the arrangements please get in touch with the British Council office by **24 April 2017**. We will not be able to accommodate clash arrangements on the exam day if approval is not taken from British Council in advance.

Similarly if you have requested for Access Arrangement and have not yet received any letter, please let us know by **24 April 2017** through an email.

PROVISIONAL RESULTS

IGCSE, GCE O and AS/A level provisional results will be available by **10 August 2017**.

WARNING
